

FEES AND APPLICATION

The fee for each camp covers the cost of instruction, housing, meals and the use of all designated facilities. **All campers will receive a 2009 Wisconsin Wrestling Camp T-shirt during check-out. A non-refundable deposit for each camp must accompany your application.** Any unpaid balance will be collected during your son's check-in. If you wish, you may pay the entire fee and submit payment with your application. Upon receipt of your completed application and deposit/payment, a confirmation letter with additional details concerning camp will be sent to you. You will also receive a separate mailing containing forms requesting health information. Please complete the health forms and return them **at least two weeks prior** to the beginning of camp. **Your son will NOT be able to participate in any camp activities until these health forms have been received, so please take the time prior to your arrival at camp to complete and return these important forms.**

Campers are encouraged to have their own health insurance as limited accident insurance is provided by the University.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Madison is located in the south central part of Wisconsin, easily accessible from highways 90/94 and 151. Transportation to and from camp is each camper's responsibility. University Housing residence halls provide student-style housing conveniently located on campus near camps. Each air conditioned room includes twin beds with bed linens and pillows, micro-fridges, desks, Internet and cable television connections (via personal laptop) and shared bathroom facilities. Floor lounges include televisions and telephones with free local calls. Laundry and vending machines are located within most halls. Meals provide a variety of youth-friendly and healthy selections, including vegetarian options.

Campers will be housed **two** per room. We make every attempt to honor roommate requests provided the request is made two weeks prior to the start of the camp. Campers may check in at their assigned dorm at 1:00 P.M. on the first day of camp. Orientation and wrestling begin at 2:30 P.M. Check out is at 11:00 A.M. on the last day of camp. Meals will begin with dinner on the first day of camp and will end with breakfast on the last day of camp. Please plan accordingly.

These camps are instructional, but time will be allowed for competitive wrestling and recreation when appropriate. All campers are supervised to provide a safe and secure environment during all scheduled activities and while in the dorm.

WHAT TO BRING:

Each camper is expected to bring his own towels, washcloth, and personal toilet articles (toothbrush, deodorant, etc). Wrestling shoes, t-shirts, shorts, and socks will be needed. You will also need casual clothing. Your camper may bring any additional food or drink he may want. A small refrigerator is provided in each room.

Our camp store will be open between sessions and will have beverages and snacks for sale.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FULL-TIME ATHLETIC TRAINER:

A member of the University of Wisconsin Athletic Training staff will be on hand for all sessions. In addition, we have at our disposal in Madison one of the best Sports Medicine hospitals in the country. We recommend that all campers prepare themselves for the rigors of camp by being in the best physical condition possible.

CAMP BANK:

We discourage campers from having cash in their rooms. At check in, campers may deposit their cash in our Camp Store Bank and may withdraw funds during regular camp store hours at their discretion for their own use.

PARKING:

There will be access to free on-site parking for drop-off and pick-up of campers during camp check-in and check-out only. Due to the limited number of spaces that are available to us, we discourage individual campers from bringing their vehicles for the duration of the camp. If it is absolutely necessary for the camper to bring his own vehicle a parking permit must be purchased two weeks prior to check-in. Please contact our office for more details on parking permits.

REFUNDS:

In the event a cancellation is unavoidable, kindly contact the Wrestling Office (608-262-3586) **at least 72 hours prior to the start of camp.** **Although your camp deposit is non-refundable,** any additional payments that you have made will be refunded to you in August.

Please note that misconduct by campers is grounds for removal from the camp without a refund.

During this camp every area of wrestling will be covered through controlled drilling sessions and controlled live wrestling sessions. UW Wrestling Coaches will emphasize mental discipline and toughness during drilling and wrestling sessions. Each camper will receive individual personalized time and attention from a UW Coach to help them refine their skills. UW Strength and Conditioning Coach, Ben Herbert, will conduct sessions emphasizing explosive lifting techniques that are specific to the sport of wrestling. Overall this is a great camp for any wrestler who is looking for an edge next wrestling season.

The camp will consist of 80% high end skill instruction focusing on proper technique that is valuable at every level of wrestling. The other 20% will allow the athletes to test their newly learned skills in live combat situations. This is a great developmental camp for serious wrestlers in grades 4-12. Our counselors will break down and evaluate each camper. All athletes will leave camp with a better understanding of the sport of wrestling. They will be reminded of what areas they need to concentrate on to become the best they can be.

The Iron Man competition format will be changed with teams battling head-to-head. This is a great team building camp that allows coaches to work closely with the entire UW Wrestling team and staff. This camp will give a fair evaluation of where your team is at during the summer months.

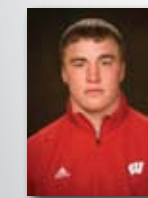
