



TICKET ORDERING GUIDE

GENERAL INFORMATION

DEADLINE FOR ORDERS

Volleyball season ticket and parking orders are due July 11, 2011. Orders not received by this date will be considered late. Late orders are subject to seat relocation.

PAYMENT

Order your tickets and parking online at UWBadgers.com It's safe, secure and eliminates the additional paperwork and mailing costs. If you have never used the online system, you will need to activate your account using your patron number and pin number located on your order form above your name and address. If you choose not to order your tickets online, please mail the WHITE copy of the order form with the appropriate payment. Please do not order season tickets by fax. Orders by phone will be accepted during regular business hours (8:30am – 4:30pm, Mon.-Fri.). Payment can be made by check, cash, MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express Card.

CONTRIBUTIONS

Individuals who contribute a minimum of \$50 to the Wisconsin Development Office will receive priority points. Please refer to your 2011 Giving Opportunities brochure or call the Wisconsin Development Office at 608.262.1000.

ADDRESS CHANGES

It is the patron's responsibility to inform the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office of any changes in your address by July 31, 2011. Please submit all address changes on your order form, in a separate letter or online at UWBadgers.com by logging into your online account.

MAILING OF TICKETS & PARKING

Season tickets and parking will be mailed in mid August via USPS priority mail service.

WILL CALL

Tickets ordered within seven days of a game will be left at Will Call. The Will Call window is located at the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at Gate 1 of Camp Randall Stadium. Regular office hours are 8:30am – 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Will Call on the day of game will open up one hour prior to the beginning of the match at the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at Gate 1 of Camp Randall Stadium. A photo I.D. is required to pick up tickets left at will call.

ADMISSION POLICY

All patrons two years and older must have a valid ticket for admission. Children under the age of two may be admitted without a ticket provided they sit on the lap of a parent or guardian.

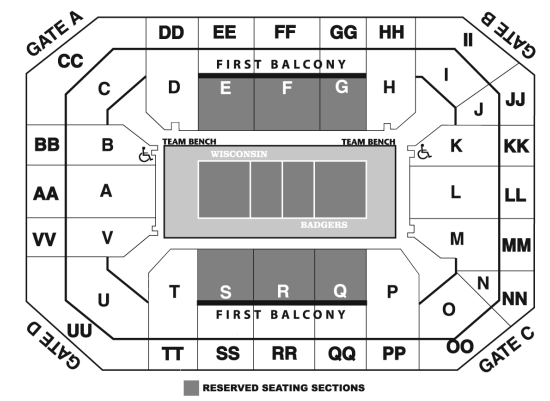
ACCESSIBLE SEATS

REFUNDS

Refunds and exchanges will not be made unless an order is not filled. Refunds will not be made due to a game time or day change.

SEASON TICKET INFORMATION



RESERVED SEASON TICKETS

Reserved season tickets are available for sale. Sections in the reserved seating area are E, F, G, Q, R, & S (first 16 rows of each section). Reserved season tickets are \$45. Seating availability is less abundant than our general admission seating options. If you or someone you know is interested in exploring the reserved seating options available please have them contact Sarah Adams, Assistant Ticket Director in the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at 608.262.6017.

GENERAL ADMISSION SEASON TICKETS

General admission season tickets are also available for sale in addition to our reserved season tickets. General admission season tickets are located in any area of the UW Field House outside of the reserved sections (E, F, G, Q, R, S). General admission season tickets are \$30 for adults and \$15 for youths (ages 2-17) & senior citizens (ages 55+).

FAMILY SEASON TICKETS

The University of Wisconsin is pleased to offer a Family Season Ticket Plan. This terrific package allows a family of four to enjoy Wisconsin Volleyball at a tremendous savings. For only \$75, you will receive four general admission tickets to all 13 home games. This is the equivalent of getting one youth general admission ticket free. Additional tickets may be added at the general admission season ticket rates.

ADDITIONAL SEASON TICKETS

If you would like to request additional season tickets, please indicate this in the comments box located adjacent to your season ticket line when ordering online. If you are not ordering online, please write this request on your order form and include payment. Seats are currently available, though additional seats will most likely not be adjacent to your current season tickets. If you would like both your additional and current seats to be together, and are willing to re-locate your seats to do so, please indicate that desire when ordering your season tickets.

CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS REQUESTING SEAT CHANGE

Keep the following points in mind if you wish to request a seat improvement.

- Changes are based on availability, annual giving level and descending priority points order within each giving level.
- The number of years requesting seat changes does not factor into the request process and requests are not carried over from the previous year.
- Requests for seating changes should be in writing and placed on, or attached to, your ticket application. If you are ordering online, please place your request in the comments box located next to your season ticket line.

Each request is reviewed by the Athletic Department, but the volume of requests may not make personal consultation feasible. Decisions are based on the best judgment of the Athletic Department. The Athletic Department reserves the right to change any seat assignment without prior notice, thus there are no guarantees.

2011 NCAA TOURNAMENT TICKETS

NCAA FIRST AND SECOND ROUND

If UW is selected to host the First and Second Round NCAA Tournament matches, season ticket holders will have priority with regards to purchasing tickets. However, due to NCAA Tournament ticket allotments and allocations, it may not be possible to receive the same ticket location for the tournament as you have for your season tickets. The Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office will do everything they can to accommodate you with comparable seating should this occur. More information will become available after the start of the season. Please note that UW is not guaranteed of hosting the first and second round.

INDIVIDUAL MATCH TICKETS

HOME SINGLE GAME TICKETS

Individual match Reserved and General Admission tickets will go on sale to the general public Monday, August 22 at 8:30 am. Tickets may be purchased by calling the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at 1.800.GO.BADGERS, ordering online at UWBadgers.com, or in person at the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office, located at Gate 1 of Camp Randall Stadium.

Individual match reserved tickets are available through advance purchase only. Reserved tickets will not be sold the night/day of the match. On the night/day of the match, general admission tickets are sold at Gate C of the Field House (The entrance off of Breese Terrace) or the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office (located outside of Gate 1 of Camp Randall Stadium) starting one hour prior to match-time. Individual match reserved tickets (advance sale only) are \$5 for all ages. General admission individual match tickets are \$5 for adults, and \$2 for youths (Ages 2-17), UW-Madison students, & senior citizens (Ages 55+).

HOME GROUP TICKETS

A minimum of 15 admissions (any combination of adult, youth/student and senior citizen tickets) must be purchased to receive the group ticket discount of \$3 per admission for adults and \$1 per admission for youth/students and senior citizens. Group tickets may be purchased in advance beginning at 8:30am on Monday, August 22 through the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office. All group tickets are general admission seating.

AWAY GAME TICKETS

Away game tickets for volleyball games are not available through the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office. Please contact the host school for ticket information and availability.

PARKING INFORMATION

SEASON TICKET HOLDERS ORDERING PARKING

Advanced sale parking for volleyball is only available on a season basis. Current permit holders should order their current parking assignment or make a request for a lot change on their season ticket order form. Season ticket holders who would like to purchase a season parking permit may also make that request on their season ticket order form. All parking requests are reviewed based on annual giving level and then by priority points within each giving level. Season parking permits will be valid for all home matches. Season parking will cost \$65, which breaks down to \$5 per match.

SINGLE MATCH PARKING

Single match parking is available for purchase on a first-come, first-served basis the night/day of the match directly from the lot attendants. There are no advanced sales for single match parking. Single match parking is \$5 per match.

PARKING LOTS

All season and single game parking for volleyball in 2011 will be located in Lot 16 (located behind the UW Credit Union off of Monroe Street) and Lot 17 ramp (situated immediately north of Camp Randall Stadium). Drop-off site for patrons with disabilities is available at Gate 1 of Camp Randall Stadium on Monroe Street and at the corner of Regent Street and Breese Terrace.
